

Step into sight words!

Do you have stairs in your house? They make a great way to practice sight words! Set your child at the bottom of the stairs, and grab (or make) a set of sight word flashcards. Each time the child reads a word correctly, he may move up a step. If incorrect, he doesn't get to move. You can do this as a race against another child to see who can get to the top first! (You could start on the middle step. If the child answers correctly, he can move up a step. If incorrect, he moves down a step.) A child could also compete against an older sibling who must answer math fact flashcards (or other) correctly. Whoever gets to the top step first wins!
